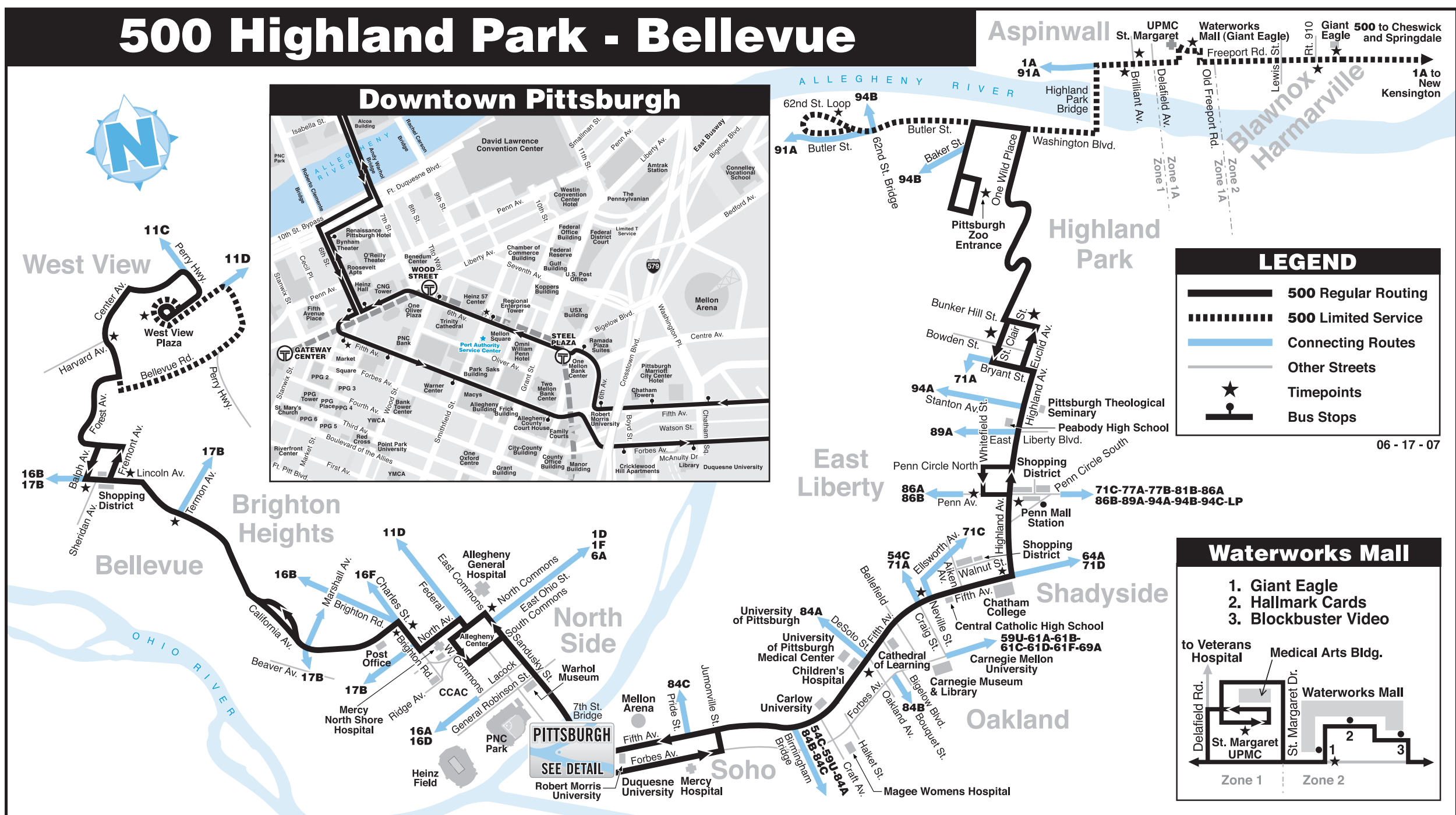


500 Highland Park - Bellevue



Ride 500 to Steeler & Pitt Football Games this season

Route 500 operates on Sandusky Street, just a few blocks from Heinz Field. This service connects many North Side and East End communities with the stadium.

Convenient 500 Highland Park-Bellevue bus service operates seven days a week.

Standard fares apply.

SCHEDULE NOTES

The following notes denote special trips indicated on the other side of this timetable.

A - Bus stops on Freeport Road at Alpha Drive East.

B - Trip will operate via **Bellevue Road**.

F - Bus stops on **Freeport Road** outside of Waterworks Plaza.

H - Trip will leave from Old Freeport Road at Freeport Road in **O'Hara** at 6:56 a.m.

W - Trip will only operate to Old Freeport Road at Freeport Road in **O'Hara**.

SERVICE NOTES

AIRPORT SERVICE

Let Port Authority take you to Pittsburgh International Airport. 28X AIRPORT FLYER operates seven days a week between 5:00 a.m. and 12 Midnight approximately every 30 minutes from Oakland, Downtown and most West Busway stations.

Free Fare Zone
Port Authority bus rides are free within the Golden Triangle every day until 7:00 p.m. (The limits of this zone are bounded by Ross St., 11th St., and the Allegheny and Monongahela rivers). Light rail rides on the "T" are free within the Golden Triangle at all times. This includes rides between Wood Street, Steel Plaza, and First Avenue stations.

Special Fares
Children (6-11) pay one-half the adult cash fare.
Children 5 and under (Up to four) ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying passenger.
Persons with Disabilities pay one-half the adult cash fare with a Medicare ID or state issued half fare card, except on weekdays between 7:00 - 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 - 5:30 p.m.
Senior Citizens Ride Free without restriction with a Medicare ID or state issued senior citizen transit pass.
Light Rail "T" - Peak Direction Surcharge on Cash Fares
A 0.75 surcharge is applied to "T" cash fare inbound from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and outbound 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on weekdays. Riders paying with passes, tickets, and transfers are not subject to pay the surcharge.

FARE ZONES

Zone 1: From West View Plaza to Highland Park, Pittsburgh Zoo & PPG Aquarium, 62nd Street Loop or Freeport Road at Delafield Road.

Zone 1A: From Freeport Road at Delafield Road to Freeport Road at Old Freeport Road.

Zone 2: From Freeport Road at Old Freeport Road to Freeport Road at Alpha Drive East or Springdale.

FARE RECEIPTS

If you are riding from West View, Bellevue, Brighton Heights, Calbride Place or the North Side and plan to ride beyond Grant Street in Downtown, you must obtain a **blue** fare receipt from the operator when paying your fare.

If you are riding from Springdale, Harmarville, Waterworks Plaza, 62nd Street Loop, the Pittsburgh Zoo & PPG Aquarium, Highland Park, East Liberty, Shadyside, Oakland or Uptown and plan to ride across the 7th Street Bridge, you must obtain a **pink** fare receipt from the operator when paying your fare.

If you do not obtain a fare receipt, and ride through and beyond Downtown, you will be required to pay a second fare upon exiting the vehicle.

You are required to give your fare receipt to the operator when you exit. The receipt must be used on the same vehicle on which it was obtained. It is not valid on any other Port Authority bus, incline or rail vehicle.

After 7:00 p.m., all fares are paid as you board. No fare receipts are needed after 7:00 p.m.
