

## SUMMARY OF RESOLUTION

### Authorization to Complete Application and Enter into Agreement with FEMA/PEMA for Reimbursement of Snow Removal Costs

In February 2010, Port Authority of Allegheny County (Authority) incurred significant costs for snow removal due to the heavy snowstorms that affected Allegheny County. These costs included expenses for overtime, materials, equipment and outside contractor assistance during an approximately 48-hour period.

The Authority submitted a request to the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) and Pennsylvania Emergency Management Administration (PEMA) seeking reimbursement of these incurred costs. FEMA/PEMA have indicated to the Authority that a percentage of these costs may be eligible for reimbursement under the Stafford Act, subject to the Authority completing a reimbursement application and entering into an agreement to receive said funds.

This resolution authorizes completion of the application process and entering into an agreement with FEMA/PEMA for reimbursement of the eligible snow removal costs incurred by the Authority.
