## Faster. Smarter. Better.

Port Authority's Transit Development Plan is the result of more than two years of planning and feedback from thousands of riders, all with the aim to make transit smarter and more efficient.

Allegheny County has changed dramatically over the last 50 years, but until now Port Authority hasn't mirrored the region's transformation. Many of the system's routes trace streetcar lines first plotted in the early 20th Century.

The Transit Development Plan and its changes will bring the system into the 21st Century while providing improved service and better choices for the vast majority of riders. New routes are being added to serve growth areas and redundant or underused routes are being consolidated. Entirely new types of service are in the works, including fast, frequent RapidBus routes in key travel corridors.

Port Authority is also working to make the system easier to learn and simpler to use for new and occasional riders as well as commuters and daily riders. Renamed routes, streamlined Downtown circulation and more consistent service will help make transit more accessible to a greater number of people.

Enclosed is the first round of changes under the Transit Development Plan. More changes will take place in June 2010 and September 2010.
