Fare Information

Beginning **January 1, 2022**, your fare will get you farther. Instead of \$2.75 per trip with a ConnectCard, transfers have been eliminated and your fare will include **FREE** transfers for up to three hours.

All passes – with the exception of the 3-hour pass and 1-day pass – will remain active from first use until the end of the service day they are set to expire.

LIGHT RAIL FREE FARE ZONE

Ride for **FREE** anytime from First Avenue Station to Allegheny Station.

SPECIAL FARES

Children ages 6-11 pay half the full ConnectCard fare with a Kid's ConnectCard. Cash half fare is \$1.35.

Children 5 and under ride **FREE** when accompanied by a fare-paying adult.

Individuals with disabilities pay half the full ConnectCard fare with a Port Authority Reduced Fare ConnectCard. Cash half fare is \$1.35.

Seniors ride **FREE** with a Port Authority Senior Citizen ConnectCard or when displaying a state-issued senior citizen transit pass.

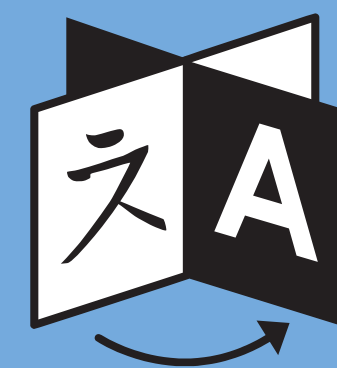

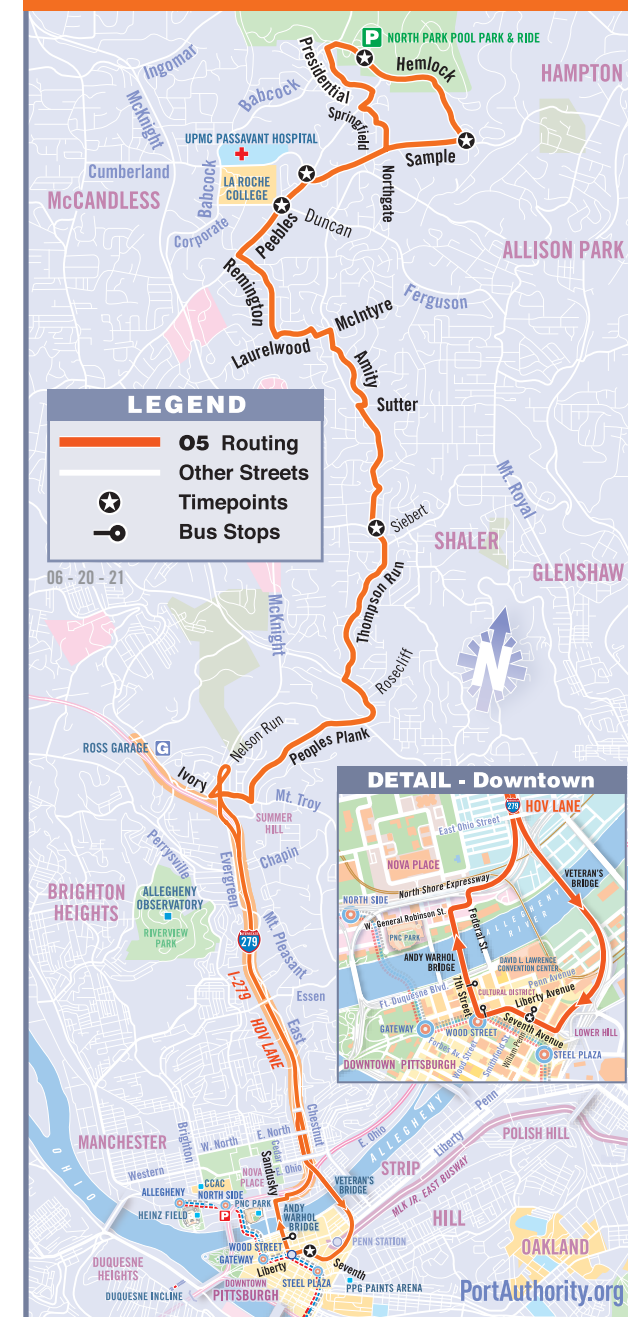
